The **Educational Test** is a scientifically valid and meaningful test, that the teacher / psychologist applies during school activities, to develop and to evaluate the skills and psycho-cognitive skills of students.

Educational Tests **allow to develop and assess the skills and competences acquired by the students, without in the educational context and in teaching-learning relationship.**

The concept of Educational Test was created by Fausto Presutti at the end of 1970.

From the analysis of the ways and rhythms of problems solving presented in the Educational Tests and of the expression of abilities / skills, we can identify the ideation path, cognitive methods and personality of the learner. According to this analysis it is possible to construct some psycho-pedagogical hypothesis of educational and psycho-cognitive intervention per pupil.

The areas of the Educational Tests that help analyze and assess the skills and abilities of each student or person are:

- *Logical-cognitive area*: realization of " **Logical succession of figures**", "**True - False?**" **Logical-Mathematical** Tests lets analyze and evaluate intellectual abilities, conceptual structures, the thought processes, reasoning strategies, the logic procedures, the complexity and the originality of cognitive solutions.

- *Artistic and creative area*: realization of "Hidden Figures " and "Creative Figures" Tests allows to analyze and evaluate the creative idea and the mental fluidity, the ability of association and global vision, flexibility in elaboration and construction of solutions, the cognitive originality, intellectual and customizing diversity of expression.

- *Psycho-social area*: the realization of "**History of the 3 symbols: Animal - Object - City and Colour, Animal, Feature**", "**Sun in the sky - Sea - Door**", "**Human figure in the Rain**" - "**Tree**" - "**House**" and "**the Monster**" Tests allows to analyze and evaluate the personal characteristics, aspects of the EGO, the emotional-relational dynamics of subjective experiences, psychic structure and the evolutionary development of the individual, the relationship with "others".
